## Recycled Material Declaration:

As reported in the “Declaration by the metals industry on recycling principles”, there are two approaches for assessing the benefits of recycling, the “recycled content” approach and the “end-of-life” recycling approach.

The recycled content approach is useful for material that would otherwise be incinerated or land filled as waste, while the end-of-life approach supports solutions where high amounts of metal are made available for the future by recycling and assists society in meeting “the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs”.

As metals are chemical elements that can be recycled infinitely with no inherent degradation of properties, Lee Brass supports the end-of-life recycling principle by producing products that are manufactured from 99.5% recycled material and are 100% recyclable at end-of-life.
